

**Prof. Junming Liu** is Professor of Physics of Nanjing University, Member of the National Laboratory of Solid State Microstructures.

He obtained his doctor degree from the Northwestern Polytechnic University in 1989. He joined the faculty of Nanjing University in Sept. 1992, after two years post-doctor experience in the same university. He was promoted to the grade of Professor in 1999 and again exceptionally to the grade of Chang-Jiang Professor in 2004. He has received “The Outstanding Young Investigators Fund of the National Science Foundation of China” in 1997, and several Research Excellence Awards in the past thirty years. He was elected as Fellow of American Physical Society in 2015.

Prof. Liu has published 900 SCI papers with more than 20000 citations and an H index of 46, and is a coordinator and a principal leader of more than 30 research and collaborative projects.

Prof. Liu's current research fields include ferroelectrics/multiferroics, multifunctional materials, and computational materials.
